

Chain of Responsibility for Lineage Logistics Australia and Supply Chain Partners

Lineage Logistics Australia encourages all Supply Chain Partners to ensure that they are familiar and compliant with the Chain of Responsibility (CoR) requirements bestowed upon them through the Heavy Vehicle National Law. This includes, but is not limited to, ensuring that drivers adhere with the sign-posted speed limit and drives appropriate to the conditions (ie weather, traffic & road), ensuring that drivers are not fatigued or under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol that may impair their ability to drive safely, appropriate load restraint is being utilised and meets the loading performance standard, vehicles are safe and not defective, and carrying loads which are within the legal limits for mass and dimension.

Compliance with all legislative authorities' requirements is imperative to ensuring the health and safety of all.

It is a duty for all CoR parties to ensure safety of the transport activities 'so far as is reasonably practicable'.
